## **PROSPECTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE EURASIAN AGROEXPRESS PROJECT**

### **Перспективы развития проекта Евразийского агроэкспресса**

The relevance of the research topic lies in the fact that currently the accents of the member states of the Eurasian Economic Union (hereinafter referred to as the EAEU) are moving from West to East. A promising project is «the Eurasian Agroexpress».

«The Eurasian Agroexpress» project is being implemented on the basis of the Order of the Eurasian Intergovernmental Council dated February 25, 2022 No. 3 «On the joint project of the member States of the Eurasian Economic Union on the implementation of accelerated rail and multimodal transportation of agricultural products and food «Eurasian Agroexpress».

«The Eurasian Agroexpress» project is accelerated container, rail and multimodal deliveries of agricultural products and food from the EAEU member states to China, Uzbekistan, Vietnam and other countries of Southeast and Central Asia.

It should be noted that the project was launched on February 25, 2022. In total, 525.5 thousand tons of chicken and beef meat, milk powder, fat-and-oil, fruit and vegetable and leguminous products were transported in 2022, of which 282.9 thousand tons of perishable goods [1].

At the Third High-level Forum on International Cooperation within the framework of the «One Belt, One Road» initiative in Beijing, which took place on October 18, 2023, Mikhail Myasnikovich, Chairman of the Board of the Eurasian Economic Commission, noted the effectiveness of cooperation between the EAEU countries and China and said that "the measures taken and the efforts of the governments of the EAEU countries and the PRC, and The EEC also allowed us to have concrete results. The trade turnover between the EAEU countries and China in 2015-2022, during the functioning of the EAEU, increased 2.8 times and actually reached \$ 220 billion, which is a record level in the history of relations». Also, as a vivid example of effective work, he noted «the Eurasian Agroexpress» project and said that «in the first year alone, within the framework of the Eurasian Agroexpress project, 18.5 thousand containers with agricultural goods were sent to China from Belarus and the regions of Russia, which is more than 7.5% of all transported similar goods in trade with China» [2]. Thus, «the Eurasian Agroexpress» project will increase the volume of agricultural products supplied by the EAEU member states to China in the amount of up to 500 thousand tons in the medium term, and up to 1 million tons per year by 2030-2035 [3].

Thus, «the Eurasian Agroexpress» project is an effective logistics system that allows you to quickly deliver products to the consumer, reduces the costs of the journey, namely time and cost. It also contributes to the development of international relations between the EAEU member states, China, Uzbekistan, Vietnam and other countries of Southeast and Central Asia.
