## **ORTHOGRAPHIC FEATURES OF ELECTRONIC DISCOURSE IN FORUMS**

### **Орфографические особенности электронного дискурса на форумах**

Internet communication plays a key role in personal relationships, business and education allowing people to communicate in real-time, access resources, and participate in global discussions. The aim of the work is to research the orthography of electronic discourse in English-speaking and French-speaking forums.

The orthography of electronic discourse in forums is unique and reflects the desire for fast information exchange. One of the key orthographic features is the *simplification of spelling*. Users often abbreviate words to speed up typing, e.g., «please» becomes «pls» and «people» becomes «ppl». In French-speaking forums, a similar phenomenon is observed: «c'est» becomes «c» or «s», and «tu» is shortened to «t». Such changes make the communication more responsive and are in line with the dynamics of online communication.
