

RECONSTRUCTION OF IRAQ DURING THE POSTWAR PERIOD

ВОССТАНОВЛЕНИЕ ИРАКА В ПОСЛЕВОЕННЫЙ ПЕРИОД

Война в Ираке заставила пересмотреть позиции мирового сообщества по ряду вопросов, касающихся проблем войны и мира, помощи и содействия в восстановлении разрушенной экономики и социальной сферы данного государства. В работе рассматриваются основные достижения послевоенного восстановления в этой стране.

Below are the major achievements during the post war period in Iraq.

- In the first days and months after the war, President Bush asked USAID to take responsibility for humanitarian affairs and created an inter-Agency Disaster Assistance Response Team to assess the humanitarian situation and coordinate relief. USAID technical staff went to Jordan, Kuwait, Qatar and Cyprus to prepare for post-conflict reconstruction.

- It is evident, that under Saddam, the Iraqi people had no say in their government. Now the U.S. is helping them take charge of their own affairs.

- Another important achievement is rebirth of Iraq's schools and the whole education system.

- Great work in the sphere of healthcare has been done.

- A new treatment plant has been built in Basra with the help of the U.S. and CPA. It provides 40,000 people in south-east Iraq with clean drinking water.

- During the post war period a deep water port was re-opened. U.S. contractors restored power stations and bridges while repairing water and sewage systems vital to Iraqi's health.

- With the U.S. assistance the reconstruction of Iraq's electricity plants was started.

- Over the past year, the U.S. assistance supported reforms that stimulate international trade and generate employment.

- The establishment of good government is another major achievement.
