The purpose of the article is to find out which gestures are the most popular among young people in the Republic of Belarus. After my research, the most used gestures among young people were identified as:

- gestures using the index finger. For example, twisting a finger at the temple information about the insanity of the interlocutor, fitting a finger to the lips a request for silence;
- gesture with the middle finger. Currently, this gesture is used among young people for an insulting request to leave;
- "OK" with the thumb and forefinger brought together in a ring. This gesture means that everything is in order with a person;
- "hearts". Of course, they are needed to express love and sympathy for a person. There are several examples with the image of the "heart":

the thumb and forefinger are folded perpendicular to each other, the remaining fingers are bent into a fist;

the thumbs touch each other from below, the remaining fingers form an arc and fold from above (that is, we show us the familiar heart);

we raise our hands up, forming an arc, and touch our heads with our fingers, so we make a big heart.

Of course, there are a huge number of gestures, but I have listed some of the most popular signs among young people living in our country. Most of them are borrowed from the United States, South Korea, America. In the modern world, it is difficult to speak and express one's thoughts and emotions without gestures, since in many situations they turn out to be more effective than speech, and sometimes only gestures (without words) can tell the necessary information.

Terms are created artificially according to certain rules from certain elements. If you master these rules and know these elements, you can learn to understand even new terms. Let's give an example: psychology is the science of mental activity, whereas psychiatry is the treatment of mental disorders, and psychotherapy is treatment by influencing the psyche. Words and elements of Latin words have entered all languages of the world: mobilis — mobile — mobil — móvil, etc.

Thus, we see that knowledge of Latin word formation facilitates understanding not only Latin, but also most modern Western languages. The importance of Latin is still great. Latin is the official language of the Vatican, the international language in the field of botany. Newly discovered plant species should be described in Latin. The Latin language is necessary for physicians, biologists, since all terminology is built with the help of Greek-Roman word- forming elements.
